

Certified Professional Coder(CPC) Course

The Medical Coding Course offered by On the Money Medical billing, is for students who are interested in a career in the health care industry as medical coders. Jobs in this industry may be located in doctors' offices or other health care facilities, insurance companies, and third-party businesses dealing in medical and insurance claims.

While there are no mandatory educational requirements for this program other than a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent, a successful medical coding specialist will have a strong knowledge of biology, anatomy, physiology, and medical terminology.

- Medical Terminology
- Standard Medical Coding Guidelines
- Laws and Ethics related to medical records and patient information
- Abstract information required to support accurate coding.
- Ability to identify documentation discrepancies and properly query providers for proper code capture. The ability to assign accurate CPT®, HCPCS Level II, and ICD-10-CM Volume 1-2 medical codes for diagnoses and procedures.
- Understanding of anatomy, physiology, and medical terminology
- Proficiency across a wide range of services, including evaluation and management, anesthesia, surgery, radiology, pathology, and medicine.
- Knowledge of medical coding guidelines, including compliance and reimbursement – allowing a CPC to better handle issues such as medical necessity, claims denials, bundling issues, and charge capture.

Certified Professional Coder(CPC) Course is a 16-week course, conducted mainly online, with in person classes offered one day a week. Upon completion of the program students are eligible to take CPC - Certified Professional Coder.

Certified Professional Biller Course

On the Money Medical Billing's billing course that will prepare medical billers with the skills needed to perform and maintain aspects of the revenue cycle. That being said, upon completion of the course, the student can demonstrate the following:

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- Understanding of the various types of insurance plans
- How to use and apply various payer policies, such as Local Coverage Determinations (LCD), and National Coverage Determinations (NCD) for successful claim submissions
- Knowledge of CPT®, ICD-10-CM, and HCPCS Level II coding guidelines (Basics)
- Be able to understand the rules and regulations applying to the healthcare industry, including HIPAA, False Claims Act, Fair Debt Collections Act, and Stark
- Understanding the process, a medical billing claim follows to help improve the revenue cycle
- Effective claim follow-up, patient follow-up, and denial resolution

Exam Recommendation

The CPMA® examination is recommended for a certified coder or medical record auditor who has experience auditing physician services or significant coding experience and is well versed with a variety of different types of audits including but not limited to E/M services. Auditing involves compliance and regulatory issues in its day to day work, and the examinee will be tested on these concepts in addition to coding, modifiers, NCCI usage, and more
